+ Comparatives and Superlatives

For some adjectives of two syllables and all adjectives of three or more syllables use **less** or **more** to form **Comparatives** and **most** or **least** to form **Superlatives**.

Examples: Comparatives

The blue jeans are **more expensive than** the black jeans.

The black jeans are **less expensive than** the red jeans.

Examples: Superlatives

The blue jeans are **the most expensive** of them all.

The black jeans **are the least expensive** of them all.

Use **as** **as** to compare people, places or things and show how they are or aren't similar.

Examples: **as** **as**

That motorcycle is **as expensive as** this car.

My girlfriend is not **as intelligent as** me.

PAST CONTINUOUS (WAS/WERE + -ING)

AFFIRMATIVE

*I /She/He WAS play**ING** football*
*You/They WERE fish**ING***

NEGATIVE

*I /She/He WASN'T play**ING** football*
*You/They WEREN'T fish**ING***

INTERROGATIVE

*WAS she / he play**ING** football?*
*WERE you/they fish**ING**?*

USE

- o Action going on at a certain time in the past

Example: When I was having breakfast, the phone suddenly rang.

- o Two actions happening at the same time (in the past)

Example: While she was preparing dinner, he was washing the dishes.

SIGNAL WORDS

When, while, as long as, yesterday at 6 o'clock..
