



We use a relative clause to give extra information about the nouns in the main clause, without starting another sentence.

The relative clause goes immediately after the noun it relates to.

The relative pronouns are:

WHO: it is used to talk about people

THAT: it is used to talk about objects, animals, places, plants, food ect...

- It was Charles Darwin who made the Islands famous.
- The animal that is the best known of all is the Galapagos Tortoise.
