Comparatives and Superlatives:

Comparative is used when comparing two things.

To compare, we use the adjective + er + "than".

Examples:

- Ana's Hair is long. Maria's hair is longer than Ana's hair.
- Henry's turtle is big. Henry's cat is bigger than his turtle.

Superlative is used when comparing three or more things. We use a superlative to say that a thing or person is the most of a group. To form the superlative, we add -est to the adjective and we use "the".

Examples:

- But Melissa's hair is the longest of them all.
- But Henry's dog is the biggest pet.
